

Race continues over the Seven Sisters

Overnight teams continued to arrive into TA4 at Korgen Camping ground, Norway. As some teams were arriving after completing the Oxtindern ridge climb and 13km mountain bike, others were leaving on their 6h ride to the start of the "Seven Sisters" mountain trek.



Teams enjoyed a picturesque ride to TA5 and the start of the 35km Seven Sisters trekking section. The first team to the Seven Sisters was Team Finland, followed by Nike, with Lundhags and Golite two hours behind. Teams had to find two check points before traveling to TA6 and the start of the inlines section. Finland maintained their lead and arrived to TA6 1,5h ahead of Nike. Both Nike and Finland slept before departing, to coordinate with the tides, for the ocean kayak.

14 teams are currently trekking over the Seven Sisters. One of those teams, Aberdeen Asset Management from the UK, recently contacted Race Organizers regarding an injury and has chosen to withdraw. Aberdeen Asset Management are currently trekking down from the Seven Sisters range to meet with medical staff.



Remaining teams are working hard to meet the race cutoff times set by Mikael Nordström. Teams must begin the ocean kayak section by a set time, or face disqualification. Team Bosi Colombia chose to withdraw from the race earlier today and will be traveling back to Race HQ with Aberdeen.

Finland left TA6 at 15.32 followed by Nike at 16.05. Both are currently on inlines and heading towards TA7 and the start of the huge 90km Ocean Kayak. Teams Lundhags and Golite has left TA6 to chase Finland and Nike.
